WHAT TO BRING AND TIPS TO REMEMBER

The *M.V. Aurora Explorer* is a working freight vessel and the atmosphere on board is "casual". For outdoor wear we recommend soft-soled shoes and a warm jacket, as even during the summer months, breezes can be cool. We recommend that you bring some wet weather gear and boots for shore excursions, particularly in the spring and fall. Indoors we recommend soft-soled shoes or perhaps a pair of slippers. Please remember your housecoat as the passenger washrooms are shared. The crew have their own facilities.

Dinner will be served on the day of departure but not on the day of return.

Wine is served with the evening meal and you are welcome to bring additional spirits and beverages as there is no bar service available on board. A full range of soft drinks and juices are provided. Please remember that the entire interior of the vessel is non-smoking and a designated smoking area is located outside. Soft luggage, "duffel bag" style is recommended, as this will fit most conveniently beneath your berth. The M.V. Aurora Explorer's staterooms are equipped with 110-volt outlets, opening windows, mirror, night stand, small hanger rail and binoculars.

Please attempt to bring a minimum of luggage but do remember your camera and battery charger etc. A small assortment of keepsake apparel is available for purchase on board. If you wish to extend gratuities there are envelopes provided and we suggest cash be used. Towels and linen are provided fresh at intervals in your trip. Upon arrival at Marine Link Tours check-in, **please leave your luggage in your vehicle**. We will tag and collect it for placement in your stateroom in advance of passenger loading. Our parking area is secure and at no charge.
